### **Nassau, Bahamas:**

For a city now known for its warming sun and balmy breezes, Nassau has a tumultuous past. First settled by the English, the area was contested by England, France and Spain. For many years, Nassau was a home base for notorious pirates, and it was burned to the ground by the Spanish three different times. ### **Charlotte Amalie, St. Thomas:**

The Card Player Cruises staff will be happy to spread any game and limit that enough players want to play.

A general guideline regarding the games and limits on most cruises is as follows:

Texas hold'em: \$2-\$4, \$4-\$8, \$10-\$20, \$20-\$40

Omaha/8: \$4-\$8, \$10-\$20, occasionally higher

Mixed games: \$20-\$40, occasionally higher

No-limit hold'em at blinds of \$1-\$2 and \$2-\$5 with capped buy-ins
