## Basseterre, St Kitts & Nevis

St. Kitts is known for its multi-hued beaches as well as its rain forested mountains. Basseterre, the capital of St. Kitts, is a combination of historic buildings mixed in with some modern architecture. You can tour the entire island by following a road that goes around its perimeter. A narrow-gauge St. Kitts Scenic Railway offers a 3.5 hour, 30-mile circle tour of the island on its double-decker, open-air coaches. The fairly new cruise ship terminal has lots of shops and restaurants where one can stroll for a few hours. Several beautiful beach clubs have been built for those who want to kick back and enjoy a lazy day.



## Philipsburg, St. Maarten

There are some "must-see" spots on St. Maarten...the clothing optional, beautiful Orient Beach, the Princess Juliana airport where you can watch airplanes coming in to land fly closely over the heads of tourists, and the flea market and delicious bakeries in the French side's capital city of Marigot. St. Maarten is a beach lover's paradise offering at least 20 white, sandy beaches around the island. Passengers can take a water taxi to Philipsburg, the capital of the Dutch side, and enjoy shopping and dining at a variety of restaurants.



## San Juan, Puerto Rico

San Juan is Puerto Rico's capital and largest city. It attracts tourists from around the world because of its climate (an average daily temperature of 80 degrees) and its bars, nightclubs, beaches and casinos. Many historical buildings, monuments, and fortresses dating back to the 16th century are still in existence today. Be sure to get to know the locals; Puerto Ricans are known for their warm and friendly personalities.



## Labadee, Haiti

Royal Caribbean's leases the private island of Labadee to provide a relaxing stop for its passengers. A complimentary barbecue lunch is served to all passengers. The island offers lots of beaches and bays as well as many attractions and activities such as a Haitian flea market, an aqua park, the world's longest over-the-water zipline, parasailing, kayaking, numerous bars, local entertainment, snorkeling, jet skis, an alpine coaster, and lots of watersports. Labadee's natural beauty should not be missed!



## Poker Room

Limit hold'em: \$2/\$4 – \$4-\$8 and higher upon request No-limit hold'em: \$1/3, \$2/5, and higher upon request Omaha/8: \$4/8 and often higher (\$10/20 on up)

Mixed games: Mixed games upon request Tournaments will be announced.

## Staterooms – Freedom of the Seas

### Owner's Suite with Balcony (OS)

These luxurious suites offer separate living areas and private balconies. Marble entry with door bell. Queen-size bed, bathroom with tub. Separate living area with a double sofa bed. (596 sq. ft., balcony 204 sq. ft.) Also includes dry bar, minibar, entertainment center including a 42" flat screen TV, stereo and DVD player, dinette for four, vanity area, hair-dryer, phone, vanity table with an extendable working surface for laptop computers and 110/220 electrical outlets. Sleeps up to four people and can accommodate a rollaway bed and/or Play Yard.



### Grand Suite (GS)

Marble entry. Room has two twin beds that convert to Royal King, private balcony, sitting area and private bathroom with tub. Also includes minibar, TV, stereo, DVD player, larger private bathroom with bathtub and double sink, vanity area, hair-dryer, phone, vanity table with an extendable working surface for laptop computers and 110/220 electrical outlets. Sleeps up to four people and can accommodate a rollaway bed and/or Play Yard.



### Junior Suite with Balcony (JS)

Junior Suite w/Bal Accessible (362 sq. ft., balcony 86 sq. ft.) Two twin beds that convert to a Royal King size bed with open bed frames, automatic wider entry door, turning spaces, private balcony, sitting area with lowered vanity, closet rods, and safe, and a private bathroom with a wider door, roll-in shower, grab bars, fold-down shower bench, hand-held shower head, raised toilet, and a lowered sink.



### Superior Ocean View with Balcony (D3)

These luxurious staterooms offer a sitting area and private balcony. Two twin beds that convert to Royal King, sitting area, private balcony and private bathroom. (199 sq. ft., balcony 65 sq. ft.) Also includes minibar, vanity area, hair-dryer, TV, phone, computer jack, vanity table with an extendable working surface for laptop computers and 110/220 electrical outlets. Some have a Pullman bed and and/or a sofa bed and can accommodate 3-4 guests. Some can also accommodate a rollaway bed or Play Yard.



### Ocean View (Outside) (I)

Two twin beds that convert to a Royal King and private bathroom. (159 sq. ft.) Also includes minibar, hair-dryer, TV, phone, vanity table with an extendable working surface for laptop computers, and 110/220 electrical outlets. Some have Pullman beds and can accommodate 3-4 guests.



### Interior Stateroom (N)

Two twin beds that convert to a Royal King and private bathroom. (150 sq. ft.) Also includes minibar, hair-dryer, TV, phone, computer vanity table with an extendable working surface for laptop computers, and 110/220 electrical outlets. Some have Pullman beds and can accommodate 3-4 guests.
